Cadmium, Nickel Metal Hydride, Nickel, Sealed Lead Acid.*

WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD WASTE.**

- Telephone and Answering Machines
- Cellular Devices/Pagers
- Aftermarket Vehicle Audio & Video
- Image, Audio and Video Devices
- Portable Computers
