Where it all began.

On August 24, 1914, Captain Harry Colebourn, a Canadian Army Veterinarian, purchased a black bear cub for \$20 in White River, Ontario. The bear was named 'Winnie' after Colebourn's hometown Winnipeg, Manitoba. Winnie journeyed overseas and was left at the London Zoo for safe keeping when the troops went to France for active duty. Becoming the Zoo's feature attraction Winnie captivated many, especially young Christopher Robin, son of the author A.A. Milne. Inspired by the bear and his son's enthrallment,

A.A. Milne began the stories of Winnie the Pooh. Although Winnie went to that "Great Hunny Pot in the Sky" in May 1934 at the age of 20. Milne's books kept the Canadian bear alive through several generations. In 1988, some local residents discovered that Winnie the Pooh is originally from White River, and White River proudly proclaims its status as the birthplace of Winnie the Pooh by celebrating with Winnie's Hometown Festival held the third weekend in August every year. Join



the 36th Annual Winnie's Hometown Festival, "Winnie and Friends Fitness Frenzy", which is recognized and promoted by Festivals and Events Ontario. People of all ages will enjoy a fun-filled weekend of activities including: dances, fireworks, parades, trade show, and much more.
